What is a Parklet?

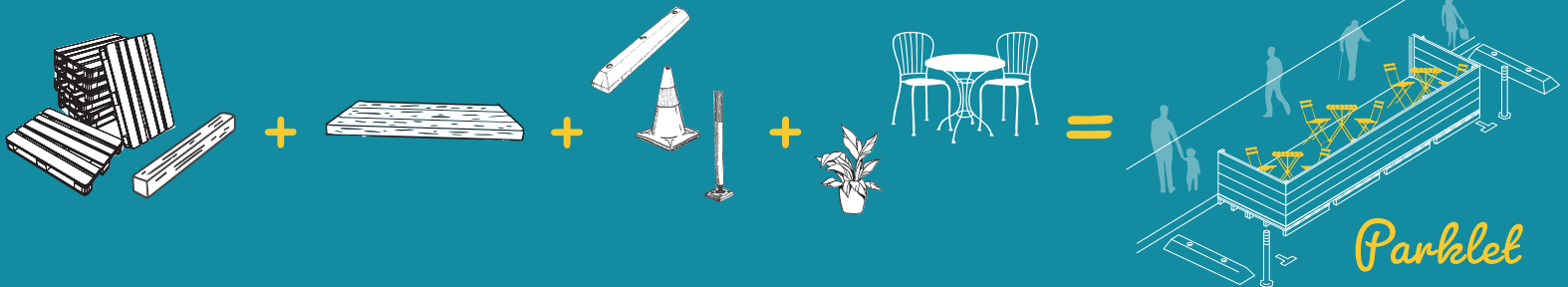
A parklet is an extension of the sidewalk into the parking lane, designed to create more public space for seating, dining, and other amenities.
