Mayor Fulop Announces Pothole Repairs to Begin with Cold Patching throughout City; Residents Encouraged to Report Locations of Potholes for Repair

JERSEY CITY – **Mayor Steven M. Fulop** announced today that the **Department of Public Works** will deploy three crews tomorrow **to begin patching potholes** created from the winter storms, one of the severest on record. Residents are also being asked to submit pothole locations to the Resident Response Center for repairs.

Tomorrow, one crew will begin at Central Avenue and Manhattan Avenue heading north, one at Westside Avenue and Danforth Avenue heading north and one at Washington Street and Second Street heading north.

Any resident wishing to report a pothole can do so through the Jersey City mobile app – the **JC RRC FIX IT** app – available for free in both the iTunes and Android mobile app stores. Residents can take a photo of the pothole submit it directly through the app.

In addition to registering potholes, residents can identify a range of constituent concerns via the app directly to the Resident Response Center. Examples include graffiti, loud noise, garbage, and more.
