***Jersey City Reminds Residents Of Public Locations to Take Shelter
During Cold Winter Weather; Public Libraries, Senior Centers, Nutrition
Sites and Other City-Funded Centers Open to Residents***

JERSEY CITY – Mayor **Steven M. Fulop** and the **Department of Health and Human Services** are reminding residents that they can find shelter from the cold temperatures hitting the area this week by visiting any one of the Jersey City Public Libraries, city senior centers and nutrition sites, as well as city-funded centers.

In addition, Garden State Episcopal Community Development Corporation will pick up anyone at PATH locations and bring them to additional sites for overnight stays. Temperatures are expected to remain in the low 20s and 30s through Saturday, with snow expected for the area on Friday.
