## Public Notice Announcement

**On Tuesday, January 18, 2022**, the Division of Community Development (DCD) will issue an open and competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Violence Prevention Program to provide funding to eligible programs and projects sponsored by public agencies, developers or not-for-profit organizations. The City of Jersey City is scheduled to receive approximately \$500,000 for the 2022 program year.

The City encourages local community groups who provide quantifiable benefits to the low and moderate-income population to apply. Since the funding source is limited, this is a competitive application process. The review criteria and eligibility requirements are noted in the RFP. The City of Jersey City HUD Entitlement Program goals are consistent with its adopted 2020-2024 five-Year Consolidated Plan as well as the National Objectives defined by HUD.
